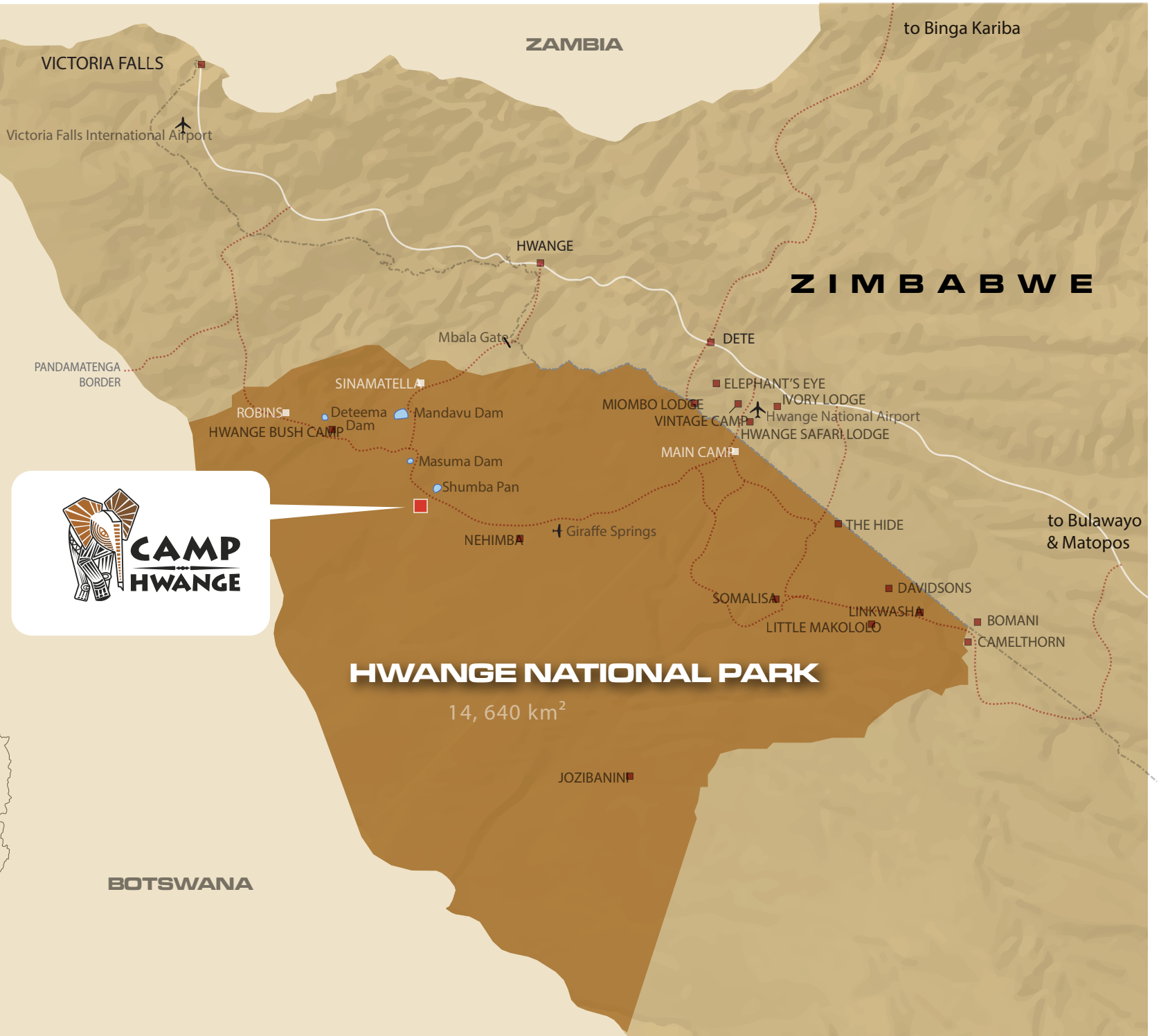
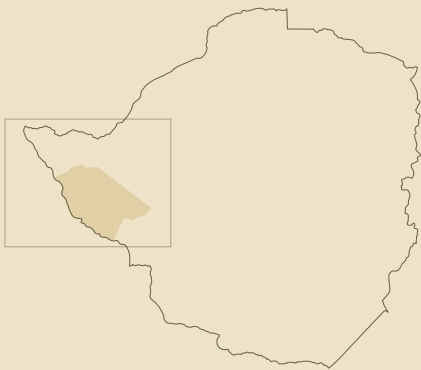




HWANGE NATIONAL PARK

LOCATION

A Classic Safari Camp situated in its own private concession deep in the Sinamatella area, situated in the north part of the Hwange National Park.

Hwange National Park is Zimbabwe's largest park and is truly one of its best. Our Camp is a 4 hour drive from Victoria Falls. One hour being on a very good tarred road and the next hour to Sinamatella on a dirt road. The final 2 hours will be through the National Park and will be treated as a game drive.

Camp Hwange is a very intimate camp, perfect for guests who want a truly wilderness experience and a wonderful feeling of being in large open areas.

ACCOMMODATION

- 18 beds available: 7 chalets - 14 beds, 1 family chalet - 4 beds.
- Twin or kingsize beds available
- Children under 14 years can be accommodated on the room sleeper couch
- Large, spacious thatched chalets with canvas & gauze sides
- Each chalet with en suite flush toilets, walk in shower & wash hand basin
- beds have large mosquito net and overhead fans
- All geyser, fans & lighting operate on solar power lowering our environmental footprint
- Each chalet has a bank of universal charging points for all electronic equipment as well as an electronic safe to store your valuables.

CATERING

Our wholesome cuisine includes a good selection of meats, vegetables and fruits. We can cater for vegetarians or anyone with food allergies.





ACTIVITIES

Our activities are centred on game drives and walks or a combination of the two. We are able to conduct these activities on our private concession and we also have access to the Hwange National Park as a whole.

Walks are especially exciting and our professional licensed guides pride themselves on their knowledge of the big and small things that make up the environment. We also offer night drives on our concession where you get to experience what goes on in the wild after dark.

There are a number of water holes in the area that attract an abundant variety of animals and birdlife.

TRANSFERS

Camp Hwange meets inbound & outbound transfers at Mbala Gate at 09h30. For clients coming off international flights this can be arranged at a later time.

Transfers can be arranged on request from Main Camp, Hwange National Airport & Giraffe Springs airstrip.

Self Drive directions are available on request.

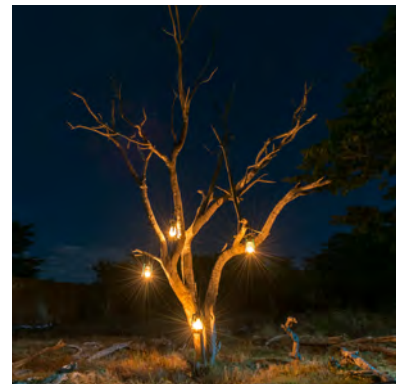
Vic Falls to Mbala gate	1½ hours drive

FACTS & FACILITIES

- The main living area includes a dining, bar and lounge area with an open air fire pit with incredible view of the stars
- Fully inclusive rate includes all meals, beverages, accommodation, activities, laundry & medical evacuation cover. Park fess and transfers are not included.
- Gratuities and all items of a personal nature are not included
- Children over the age of 8 years are most welcome, children at Camp Hwange should be under the supervision of their parents or guardian at all times.
- Children ages 8 to 12 years will be charged 50% of the adult sharing rate. Children over 12 years will be charged full adult rate.
- All children aged between 8 & 14 years should be accompanied by one parent or guardian in the room at night
- The age limit for children on a walking safari is 12 years and above, however, this will be at the discretion of the Professional Guide in camp.
- Game drive vehicles seat 6 pax per vehicle
- Families with children are assigned their own vehicle. Depending on the number of pax the family may be required to hire their own vehicle. 4 pax & below.
- All guests must sign our indemnity form
- 220v electricity through inverter is supplied to all the chalets. All Chalets have a universal bank of adaptors to fit everyone's needs
- Private vehicles can be arranged prior to arrival at an additional charge
- Please note Camp Hwange is not wheelchair friendly but staff assist as required
- Camp Hwange does not offer babysitting service
- No Wi-Fi is available

A TYPICAL DAY AT CAMP HWANGE



When guests arrive at our camp they will meet their guide who will take them on safari activities and it is with this person that everything will be planned. The following description of a typical day is just a guide line.

The best thing about a typical day at Camp Hwange is that we do our best not to make it typical.

Mostly it is an early start just before dawn, steaming mugs of tea or coffee, a light breakfast of toast, porridge or cereal and off on an activity.

In the mornings when it is still cool and the light is soft for photography, the air of expectancy is everywhere. It is nice to cruise along in the vehicle getting a few pictures of animals here and there. Your guide will be scowering the road for tracks of some of the animals that rule the night i.e. lion, hyena and leopard to mention a few. Should you not find them in the vehicle, but find their tracks especially the lion then it is time to get out and track them on foot. Whether you see them up close or as a flash running away, time on foot with lion is a thrilling way to spend the morning.

If there are no animals to track a walk in the rocky hills or along a spring line with a knowledgeable guide is well worth it. There is always something to see and it gives you time to appreciate your surrounds.

Due to us staying out the whole morning we carry with us fruit, homemade cookies, tea and coffee. As the morning warms up and it starts to get hot this is a good time to be at one of the water points, to wait and see what comes down to drink. It can be very rewarding indeed especially in the dryer months when all the animals congregate around the water points.

Usually toward midday if you have not taken a packed lunch, this is a good time to head back to camp for a large lunch and then a siesta. Full bellies equals' great afternoon nap, fantastic.

Well rested we meet back late afternoon have tea/coffee with some snacks to keep us going until dinner, and then it is off either on a drive or a walk out of camp. In the dryer months walking to the log hide in front of camp is one of the most rewarding things to do. In the log hide you can have elephants coming within meters of you, zebra

coming to quench their thirst, warthogs trotting in for a quick mud bath, the birds to find the hide and so the light is usually soft and picture taking at a premium.

As the sun sets in come the double banded sand grouse with their funny little calls, get a quick drink do a bit of socialising and then off again. During this time a nice cold gin and tonic or whatever your preference is, is a great way to witness all the goings on at our little corner of Africa.

A night drive on the way back to camp is a nice way to end off and hope to see the nocturnal animals, like springhares, serval, honey badgers, bat eared fox and if you are lucky a leopard or an Aardwolf!!!

All that is left is to gaze at the limitless stars around the camp fire, have dinner and rest because tomorrow is coming and there is always lots of exciting things to do at Camp Hwange



ACCESS CAMP HWANGE

MBALA GATE

Daily scheduled road transfers can be arranged leaving Victoria Falls at 08h00 every day. Collections can be done from any of the hotels in and around Victoria Falls.

See transfer times below:

Victoria Falls to Mbala Gate	2hour road transfer – Airconditioned Minibus
Mbala Gate to Camp Hwange	2hour game drive through the park – safari vehicle

Collections from Victoria Falls Airport later in the day can be arranged for clients coming off International and Regional flights.

HWANGE MAIN CAMP

Daily road transfers from Hwange Main Camp for clients coming from or going to any of the camps in the south of the Park. Collection and drop off times are flexible and are arranged closer to the time of travel.

Clients who wish to self-drive all the way to Camp Hwange must have 4x4. Entry into the park must be no later than 15h00. Parks fees are to be paid by the client on entry into the park.

We are able to collect self-drive clients who wish to leave their vehicles at Hwange Main Camp. There is parking available at Hwange Main Camp at your own risk and there is a small fee of \$5 payable to National Parks.

Hwange Main Camp to Camp Hwange	2hour transfer through the park – safari vehicle
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CHARTER FLIGHTS

Daily collections from Hwange Main Airport. Charters cannot land later than 15h00.
Daily collections from Giraffe Springs Airstrip.

Hwange National Airport to Camp Hwange	2h30m road transfer through park
Giraffe Springs to Camp Hwange	1hour game drive

CHARTER FLIGHTS ex VICTORIA FALLS AIRPORT

We can arrange the collection of guests from their respective hotels and transfer to the Victoria Falls Airport for charter flights to Camp Hwange.

Victoria Falls Airport to Giraffe Springs	charter time 45mins
